With the company's proposed elimination of 252 jobs, you have stood strong. The employees in the affected areas have led the marches in the shop. Your Negotiating Committee is not backing down on this proposal either. It is unacceptable to contract out these jobs. They have told the company their proposal is unacceptable. As stated on the front side of this flyer, the company has still not discussed the most important items.

On Sunday it will be your decision on a new contract, to accept or reject. In the event there is a strike vote, we are prepared. Everything is in place to rock and roll.

Picket Captains will report to the Union Hall at 7:00 P.M. Sunday night. You will receive all pertinent information necessary to cover your assigned shifts.

In the event of a strike, President David Durbin Sr. will be at the Union Hall along with your Negotiating Committee after the vote. The Officers of the Local will also be there. Together we will help answer any questions you may have and to ensure all runs smoothly. Food will have been bought, and fire wood and burn barrels need to be moved up to the picket line. There will be much to do but we are ready to take on Pratt & Whitney.
