



Thanks For Your Help

On October 16th we had our first ever RTX wide safety stand down! Every mod center on every shift all executed their projects with great success. Many of the projects ranged from fresh eyes audits, to cut protection, to housekeeping and consolidating. No matter what your project was, everyone was working together to improve the safety of our site.

As a result we identified 684 actions that needed to be addressed. Teams worked during the stand down and were able to close over 350 of those actions that day. The remaining 325 actions are being worked by teams in each of the mod centers over the end of this year and into 2025.

Many employees had comments on the stand down needing to be a reoccurring event. Whether or not events like these become a regular occurrence is yet to be determined. The thing most evident from the event was the appreciated focus on safety and improvement. We all want a cleaner, safer workplace we can be proud of. Big Moves Coming

Pratt is about to begin work to bring in a new bonder machine. This machine requires a significant rearrangement of some areas supporting CSMC. Moves have begun to make a new area for UPS in building 150. After relocating UPS and clearing all the material from the storage room, demolition starts. This stage is where we may begin to have issues with employees that park in the Post 5 parking lot. Expect more communication as we get closer to this phase.

Once the destructive phase is over, construction begins on the new home of the CSMC chip well. This new chip well has been designed with input from our millwrights to make their jobs safer and easier in the future. The old chip well in 150 will become the new home of UPS, and the work on building 150 is complete.

All of the work in building 150 is to accommodate the increase in chip capacity. The chip well in building 220 is phased out with the new area in 150, and will undergo renovations. This will be the new home of the bonder machine.

With any construction project of this size, it is anticipated to take months to complete. Add the Pratt tax and we could be looking at a year of work. Be sure to check your email and communication screens around the shop for updates. During the project, be sure to contact a Safety Rep if you have any concerns or complaints.
