

Recently we had multiple injuries come in for people being hurt in an attempt to bypass a common safety guard most of us see every day. Guardrails in the parking lots are put in place to create barriers between people and hazards. Do not attempt to take a shortcut and go over the guardrails. When navigating the parking lots be sure to stick to the designated walkways and crosswalks. Attempting to save a few seconds getting in or out could end up costing you time out of work; should you trip and sustain an injury.

A guard, machine or otherwise, are always in place for your protection and should never be bypassed.




Upcoming Safety Stand Down
