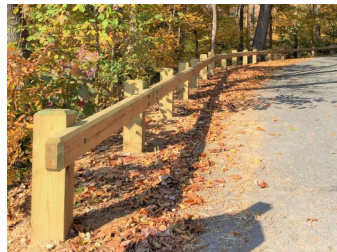

Be prepared and have the tools, should you need to make the call to save the day!

A guard, machine or otherwise, are always in place for your protection and should never be bypassed.
